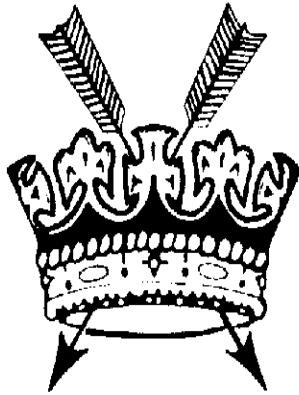

We would like you to join us as a sign of your belonging and commitment to Christ in worship and service at St Edmund's

As people who belong to Christ we are challenged:

- through supporting financially God's work at St Edmund's

As a member of the Electoral Roll you are entitled to:

- Attend and vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting
- Stand for election to serve on the Church's decision making body – the Parochial Church Council (the PCC)
- Participate in the life of the Church of England nationwide by electing representatives from St Edmunds to the Allerton Deanery Synod and through them, the Diocesan and General Synods

Planned Giving Through St Edmunds

We are delighted that you would like to join the St Edmund's electoral roll

At St Edmund's we ask members who are on the electoral roll to prayerfully consider their commitment of giving to the church.

The Church of England asks all its members to try to give 5% of their income after tax to the church.

You can give on a regular basis through the planned giving scheme by

- Asking to belong to the envelope scheme, you get an envelope each week for cash or a cheque
- Or filling in a standing order with your bank

In addition, if you are a tax payer we will ask you to fill in a Gift Aid form so that we can claim tax back from HMRC
