**God our Saviour,
look on this wounded world
in pity and in power;
hold us fast to your promises of
peace
won for us by your Son,
our Saviour Jesus Christ.**

OLD TESTAMENT READING

Psalm 104:1, 5-14, 27-33

- ¹ Praise the Lord, my soul.
Lord my God, you are very great;
you are clothed with splendour
and majesty.
- ⁵ He set the earth on its
foundations;
it can never be moved.
- ⁶ You covered it with the watery
depths as with a garment;
the waters stood above the
mountains.
- ⁷ But at your rebuke the waters
fled,
at the sound of your thunder they
took to flight;
- ⁸ they flowed over the mountains,
they went down into the valleys,
to the place you assigned for
them.
- ⁹ You set a boundary they cannot
cross;
never again will they cover the
earth.
- ¹⁰ He makes springs pour water into
the ravines;
it flows between the mountains.

- ¹¹ They give water to all the beasts
of the field;
the wild donkeys quench their
thirst.
- ¹² The birds of the sky nest by the
waters;
they sing among the branches.
- ¹³ He waters the mountains from his
upper chambers;
the land is satisfied by the fruit of
his work.
- ¹⁴ He makes grass grow for the
cattle,
and plants for people to
cultivate –
bringing forth food from the
earth:
- ²⁷ All creatures look to you
to give them their food at the
proper time.
- ²⁸ When you give it to them,
they gather it up;
when you open your hand,
they are satisfied with good
things.
- ²⁹ When you hide your face,
they are terrified;
when you take away their breath,
they die and return to the dust.
- ³⁰ When you send your Spirit,
they are created,
and you renew the face of the
ground.
- ³¹ May the glory of the Lord endure
for ever;
may the Lord rejoice in his
works –
- ³² he who looks at the earth, and it
trembles,

- who touches the mountains, and
they smoke.
- ³³ I will sing to the Lord all my life;
I will sing praise to my God as
long as I live.

GOSPEL READING

Matthew 25:31-46

- ³¹ ‘When the Son of Man comes in
his glory, and all the angels with
him, he will sit on his glorious
throne. ³² All the nations will be
gathered before him, and he will
separate the people one from
another as a shepherd separates the
sheep from the goats. ³³ He will put
the sheep on his right and the goats
on his left.
- ³⁴ ‘Then the King will say to those
on his right, “Come, you who are
blessed by my Father; take your
inheritance, the kingdom prepared
for you since the creation of the
world. ³⁵ For I was hungry and you
gave me something to eat, I was
thirsty and you gave me something
to drink, I was a stranger and you
invited me in, ³⁶ I needed clothes
and you clothed me, I was ill and
you looked after me, I was in prison
and you came to visit me.”
- ³⁷ ‘Then the righteous will answer
him, “Lord, when did we see you
hungry and feed you, or thirsty and
give you something to
drink? ³⁸ When did we see you a
stranger and invite you in, or
needing clothes and clothe
you? ³⁹ When did we see you ill or
in prison and go to visit you?”

⁴⁰ ‘The King will reply, “Truly I tell
you, whatever you did for one of
the least of these brothers and
sisters of mine, you did for me.”

⁴¹ ‘Then he will say to those on his
left, “Depart from me, you who are
cursed, into the eternal fire prepared
for the devil and his angels. ⁴² For I
was hungry and you gave me
nothing to eat, I was thirsty and you
gave me nothing to drink, ⁴³ I was a
stranger and you did not invite me
in, I needed clothes and you did not
clothe me, I was ill and in prison
and you did not look after me.”

⁴⁴ ‘They also will answer, “Lord,
when did we see you hungry or
thirsty or a stranger or needing
clothes or ill or in prison, and did
not help you?”

⁴⁵ ‘He will reply, “Truly I tell you,
whatever you did not do for one of
the least of these, you did not do for
me.” ⁴⁶ ‘Then they will go away to
eternal punishment, but the
righteous to eternal life.’
